Dr. Errico is the recipient of numerous awards and academic degrees, including a doctorate in Letters from the College of Seminarians, The Apostolic Succession of Antioch and the Church of the East • American See, a doctorate in Divinity from St. Ephrem's Institute in Sweden, and a doctorate in Philosophy from the School of Christianity in Los Angeles. This book is from one of my two favorite interpreters of biblical scripture, the other being Lamsa, with whom Errico worked. Some of the examples of how scripture can be re-interpreted using an understanding of the cultures of the region, and how they used (and still use) metaphor, symbolism, and hyperbole are a wonderful challenge to conventional understanding.
