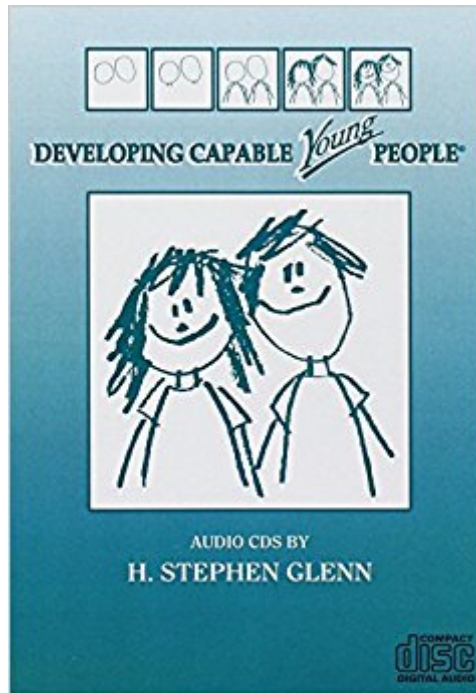

PERCEPTIONS OF INFLUENCE "My actions and choices influence what happens.

INTERPERSONAL SKILL The tools to communicate, cooperate, negotiate, share, empathize, resolve conflicts, and listen effectively when dealing with people.
