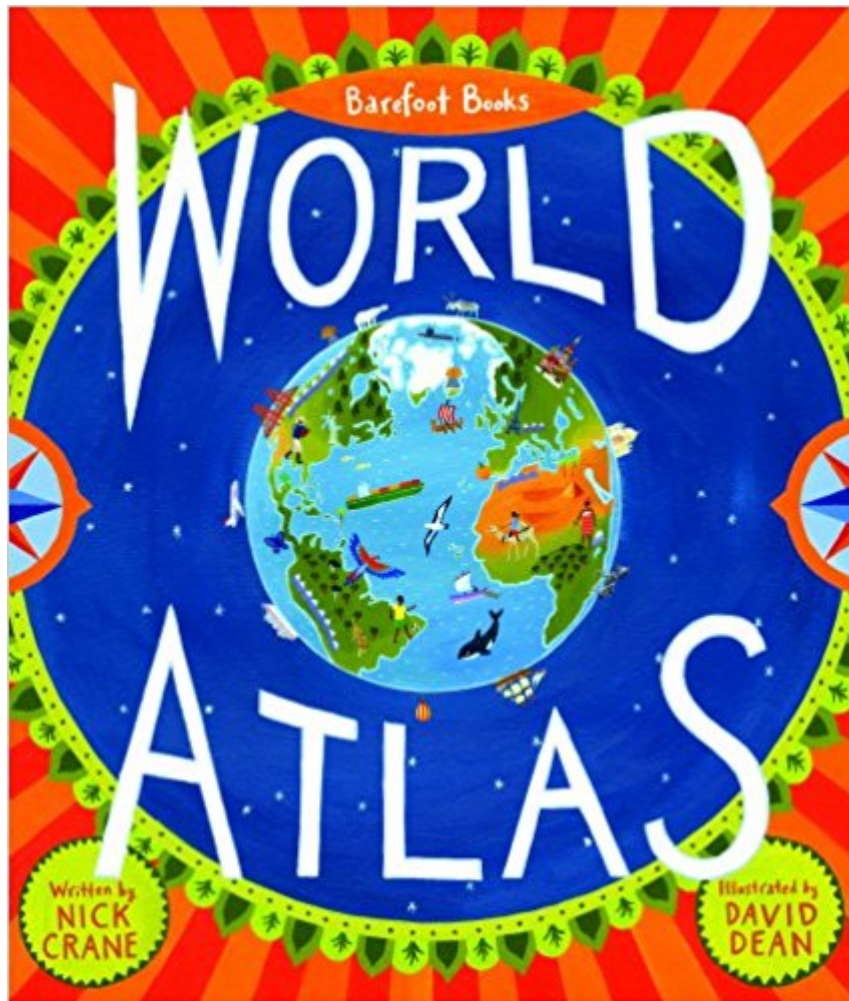

Mini-books, flaps, and sidebars address topics ranging from People and Places to Transport. Dean's maps are crowded with warmly illustrated people, animals, places, and objects that represent particular areas of the world. Ukraine is distinguished by a Cossack dancer and ornately decorated pysanka, and a ring-tailed lemur appears in Madagascar. With its emphasis on sustainability, interconnectedness, and diversity, the book offers young armchair travelers and globe-trotters much to discover.
