

The book will teach you what you want to look for in raw wood stock and how to go about, stage by stage, making a nice looking shillelagh. The second reason to read this book is to learn some history about shillelaghs as a weapon. Some heads were knocked over the course of history and it was a formidable weapon in the hands of a skilled shillelagh wielder. Very interesting stuff. Make one.

This book explains it all and even the part about the chimney. You just don't take a stick and call it a shillelagh. It explains when to harvest and the 3 year process that gives it the classic look, feel and

why it doesn't crack when used. The only problem is that they don't grow where I live so I can't make one. If you are Irish or want to be this is a great book on the history of the shillelagh that was outlawed by the English and then became the "Irish walking stick" ((Grin-Grin))
