I believe that this book is one of the best I have ever read and the fact that there is a major cliff hanger both annoys me and fascinates me. Of course that is the point of a cliff hanger I suppose. The Adventurers Wanted series is one of the only series I have finished I begrudgingly admit. Though that shows how much I appreciated these novels. M. L. Forman is a genius with his writing and I will gladly read anything else that he creates, it would honestly be an honor to read something as little as his grocery list. I read all of the books in the time span of about a month and that's truly saying something for me because I am usually not as committed to books and I'm a slower reader than most. I spent the last few days flipping page after inky page (not literally, because I was reading the third and fourth novels on kindle) reading and feeling what Alex the main character was feeling. I rate this novel a five out of five stars with the hope that others will take in mind that if you like adventure fantasy novels these are the books for you.

I loved this series since I first read Slathbog's Gold. This one is good in keeping you wondering what might happen next. The adventurers show the same good code and the need to help those on their way. The ring is finally explained and for good reason why Alex should not wear it. I have read other reviews about how the author seems to take bits and pieces of different classic adventuring/fantasy novels. I would have to agree with this assessment although I do like the spin he has put. The only bump in reading this is that he has made Alex almost perfect. Yes, he makes mistakes but on the other hand, he seems to save everyone singlehandedly. Overall, I still love this series and I really would like to know how the series turns.

The book at the moment is the first in the series that M. L. Forman hasn't written about Alex going on an adventure; rather him tuning more into his wizard self and helping others in times of need. I have been waiting months for this book to come out. Really good read, the writing may be a bit amateur for some people and it feels a little rushed but overall fantastic. I give it a 5/5 because I absolutely LOVE the series, but I could see other people giving it a 3/4. Can't wait to read more.

I have enjoyed this series from its inception. It is adventure and fantasy without being bogged down

in sex or gore. (Yes there are battles and certainly there are relationships but the details are left to the reader's imagination.) Honor and friendship are key themes throughout the series, this book is no exception. I hope the adventures continue.

I just received the book which I had pre-ordered from . I could not put the book down from the moment I started reading the first page. As a warning to people expecting the same adventure format of the last three previous books, this book is slightly different. I think the author is trying to mature Alex and making him a stronger/ more forceful character than the more fearful character he was in the previous books. Alex acts as a leader in this book even though he is not strictly speaking on an adventure in this story. The action is virtually nonstop in this book. The bad guys are much stronger and smarter in this book and the challenges are at a much higher level for Alex now. My only regret with this book is I miss all the opportunities for treasure that were in his adventures in the earlier novels. My favorite part is where we finally find out what is the mysterious ring for from the first book. That has been driving me crazy with curiosity since the first book. In conclusion Alex is a more mature/ confident character than in the previous novels and the storyline is more mature to reflect this change. Be ready for a very exciting ride. Update on next novel 10/6/2014: "The Axe of Sundering" was due to be out early 2015. I looked on the author's blog to see how things were going and unfortunately he has suffered a minor stroke affecting his left hand. I wish him a swift recovery and hope to see him back to his usual level of writing shortly.

Can't wait for the next book! The series is getting even better. This book is a bit different from the others as Alex is not technically on an adventure. I like how this book explores his responsibility and role as a wizard. I think this is my favorite book in the series so far. The other books are fun, but they follow the format of go on an adventure, find tons of treasure and go back home. This book has a bit more depth to it and isn't as predictable.

This series was entertaining, but definitely not the best book series I have ever read. Good if you are looking for a book to read for mere entertainment, but if you are looking for something special, I wouldn't recommend these.
