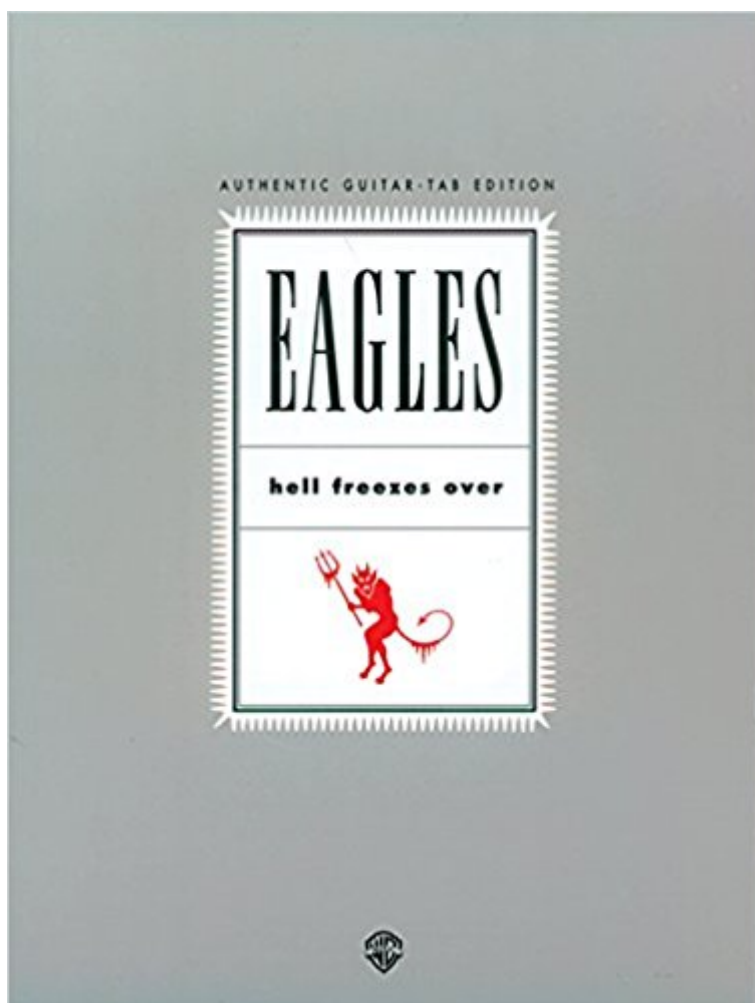

There is a reason this is the best selling music DVD on the market. The Eagles have reunited after 14 years to give a spot-on performance. It is not what you may have expected, however. The first 10 minutes are a barrage of interviews with various members of the band, as to why they decided to get back together. It seems somewhat forced, but at least they reconciled old differences enough to band together again. The rest of the DVD contains (17) seventeen songs in an intimate setting that is sparse with a simple lighting arrangement. The vocals and instrumentals are near perfect and it's hard to imagine that this much time has passed. The first several songs, "Hotel California", "Tequila Sunrise" and "Help Me Through The Night" are not as upbeat as on record, but contain some extended instrumentals as nice surprises. It isn't until "Take It Easy" (13 thirteen songs later) that the band really kicks into gear. With "Life In The Fast lane", "In The City" and the new, self effacing,

"Get Over It", the concert really continues to rock. Closing the set is the timeless, "Desperado", sung with pure emotion. It's a simple set, but well worth the admission. There is only one extra - the video to "Seven Bridges Road". I would have expected more.

I guess there isn't better video of this concert available...would have been nice to see this in HD. Well, it was nice to see the Eagles right after they got back together, were a bit nervous, and Don Felder was still in the band. When I saw that this concert had Pretty Maids All In a Row and Help Me Through the Night on it...two of my favorite Joe Walsh songs...getting this concert video was pretty much a no-brainer. This video is quite a bit different from Farewell Tour I, so it's definitely worth it to get both. This concert is more low key, acoustic, and the band was obviously younger. Ironically, the band plays more of their up beat songs and rock more on Farewell Tour I, which was shot about 10 years after Hell Freezes Over.

After reading other sterling reviews here I ordered and eagerly awaited my copy's arrival. I have a very good 5.1 system with a Harman/Kardon SACD player, several good SACD's and other multi-channel recordings, so I was anxious to see how this DVD stacked up. I have the "Hell Freezes Over" CD which sounds terrific in Pro-Logic II, but DTS is an altogether different experience. All I can say is WOW; this DVD sounds tremendous! The 24-track master recording rendered in DTS is fantastic and the video quality is quite good for 480 resolution. The Eagles' performance is, admittedly, rather laid-back on most tracks, but they do get rocking on some too. Each band member's valuable contribution is apparent and every song is nuanced in rich detail with very good instrument placement among all channels. The Bonus DVD track - in DTS audio only - of Seven Bridges Road is almost reason in itself to get this DVD. The harmony is unreal; each of the five members voices is fixed in one specific 5.1 channel, enveloping the listener with a sense of being in the center of them all. What a great way to showcase your surround system! Do yourself a favor; even if you have and collect SACD's or DVD-Audio as I do, don't pass up this sonic - and historical - masterwork.

Excellent concert video. In an Home theatre it sounds with great details. A must have for those who love great sound and clarity. Hotel California was phenomenal.

From the opening acoustic guitar solo and rhythmic beats of the bass drum, that leave no doubt you're listening to the haunting classic 'Hotel California,' this DVD is an absolute jewel! The Eagles have never sounded better than they do in this concert performance; and I'm speaking as a fan who jumped on this bandwagon before Joe Walsh joined the group. Most of their best classic tunes, from 'Take It Easy' to 'Desperado,' are included with a few soon-to-be classics thrown in for good measure. The production quality of this DVD is nothing short of exemplary. Those reviewers who tell you to measure all other DVD music videos by this one are not exaggerating. Every camera shot, lighting change, pluck of a cord, tickle of the ivories, and drum beat are exquisitely reproduced to the point that you'll think you're sitting in the first row (especially, if you're watching this on a bigscreen TV). Yes, the DTS audio is superb, but the DD encoding should not to be dismissed. The sound quality of both formats sets the bar in the stratosphere. I have yet to show this DVD video to any of my music lover friends who haven't asked where they can get a copy, and most have. Even my sweet old parents, who never knew an Eagle from a Doobie Brother had to have this DVD. Buy this DVD and you'll treasure it above all others.

While the 2.0 track is very good, the true star of this DVD is the soundtrack in DTS version. Make sure you have a killer subwoofer, turn it up, and close your eyes when the string intro to "Hotel California" kicks in and you'll think you're in the audience at the concert. Amazing sound quality, superb performances and very good choice of songs, from their old hits to their new stuff. The video quality isn't top notch, but this is basically a recording of a concert, and the music should be king -- and in "Hell Freezes Over" the music is indeed king. For the geeks out there, the average bit rate seemed to be ~7 or so. I only looked periodically, so I think that's right. What that amounts to is more space was devoted to high quality sound reproduction and so that means there's less space for "extras" -- well, there are virtually no extras on this disk. If you liked the Eagles, you'll LOVE this DVD. If you loved the Eagles, you'll be blown away. It's too bad that this DVD is still the standard by which all other concert DVDs are judged against, meaning that the studios haven't stepped up to produce more top quality concert DVDs.
