

The practice of palm reading or chiromancy can be found all over the world, with numerous cultural variations. Those who practice chiromancy are generally called palmists, palm readers, hand readers, hand analysts, or chirologists. Author Talma Brill states that she wrote this book out of a deep need to update the ancient tool of hand reading. Her intention is to shed light on how chiromancy can be used as a healing tool in the twenty-first century. She is convinced that hand reading can be combined with other scientific methods to assess human conditions, and her experience has established that hand reading can be a useful means for therapists from a variety of fields. An interesting excerpt from the preface states that, "Many people are unaware of their personal strengths and of their talents and capabilities, and many do not believe in themselves, even sabotaging their own happiness without understanding why. The attitudes of parents, family, teachers, and social and cultural environments, are assimilated at a very young age without a person being aware of it, and these frequently influence a person's potential for

self-actualization. Chirological reading, when applied correctly, may heal these wounds and guide a person back to the path which they were born to lead. Criticism of palmistry frequently rests with the lack of empirical evidence sustaining its effectiveness. Scientific literature in general regards palmistry as a pseudoscientific or superstitious belief. Skeptics often include palmists on their lists of alleged psychics who practice cold reading. Cold reading is the practice that allows readers of all kinds, including palmists, to appear psychic by using high-probability guessing and inferring details based on signals or cues from the other person. However, I am convinced in this work that the author shows an authentic and genuine concern in wanting to help people become more aware of whom they are and potentially heal any festering emotional wounds. The author makes this a very interesting and easy to read book. The writing style is conversational and clear, and she comes across as being a natural teacher, making the work very obtainable. It was an intriguing and fascinating read.
