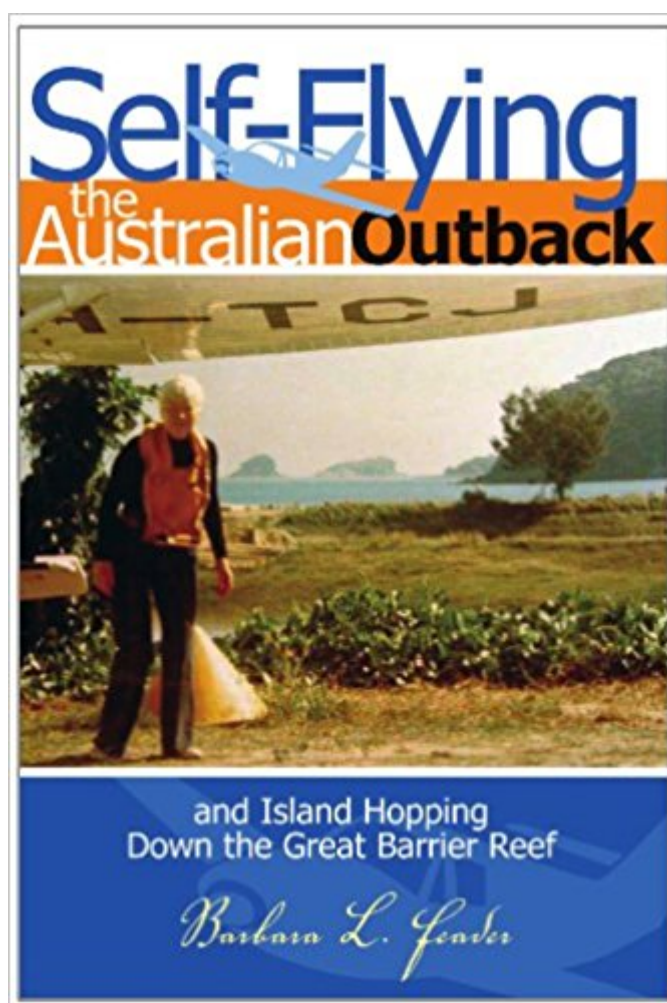


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Self-Flying The Australian Outback And Island Hopping Down The Great Barrier Reef: And Island Hopping Down The Great Barrier Reef
