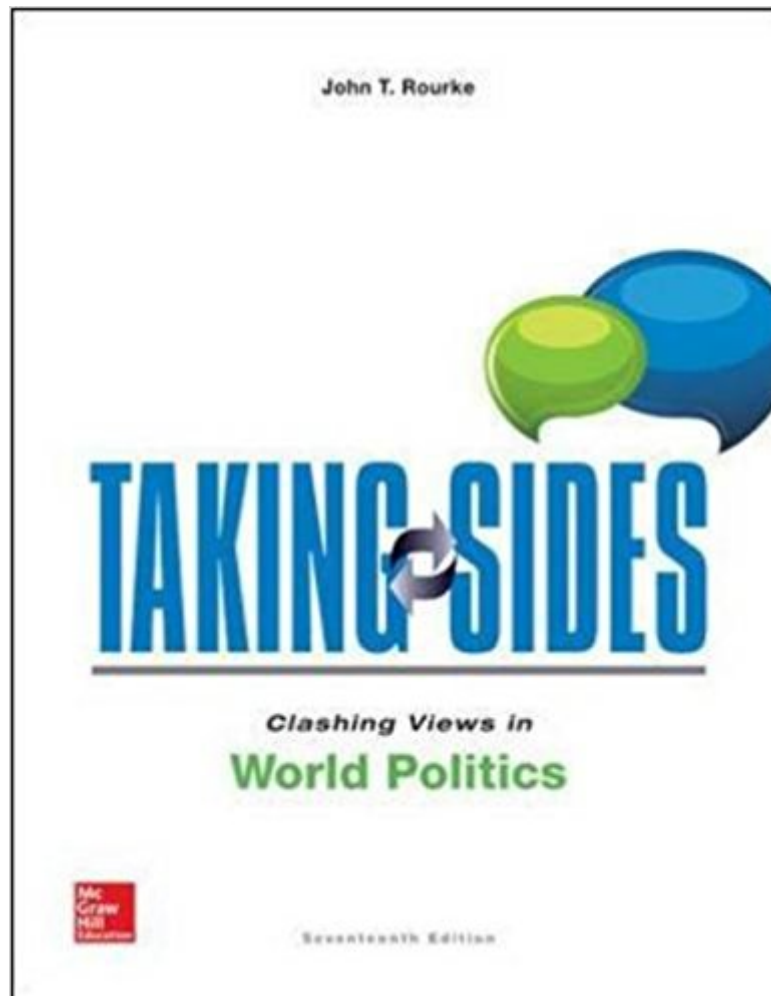




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Taking Sides: Clashing Views In World Politics

There are two ways you can use this (three if you count using the sound) - one is leaving the dome on and its soft colors in the room and the other way is to get more vibrant colors by taking the

dome off.
