I'm a fan of this series, and I really like what they've done in terms of translating the books to the manga format. I think this book is a nice, solid addition...but I didn't enjoy it as much as the previous three mainly due to how they've decided to arrange the 'chapters.' I was assuming they'd wrap up 'School's Out Forever' in this volume, as the first book, 'The Angel Experiment' only took up two manga volumes. They did not--the book will end in the next volume, which bothers me some. Aside from that nitpicky point, the book is good. The artwork is still top-notch, in my opinion, and doesn't suffer the typical lapse in quality. If you're a fan of this series, I recommend this volume, but don't be surprised if you're upset with the 'ending!'

Good book

I have mixed feelings about this manga, though I'll certainly keep buying the series as they come out. The character designs and art are generally good, consistent, not exemplary, but perfectly able to do the job. Characterization is solid, depicting primarily the darker side of the psyche, schizophrenia, xenophobia, loss of sanity, etc. I felt the plot was largely 'grab-bag', it's as if the author has put a bunch of possible plot points in a bag and is content to draw them at random, incorporating them into the story as he sees fit. Pacing is another issue, the story often seems to alternate between fast and slow, never being able to find a happy medium. Still, the manga itself somehow still manages to work, maybe because it reflects more on the haphazard, random nature of our lives where sometimes things just happen and not every event can be counted on to have meaning or advance the plot.

This book is a very good book, good story line, good art, good characters, everything is wonderful and I loved angle to them they did a very good job on making a manga and can't wait to buy more
