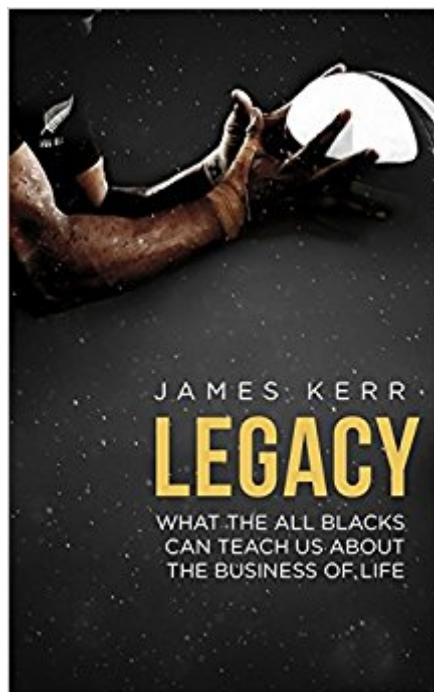

The success of the All Blacks comes from that unique combination of toughness, humility and focus on tradition that results in a reverence for the jersey. It is a credit to both organizations that the author compares the All Blacks to the United States Marines. I am a huge All Blacks fan and a Marine. I loved everything about the book except the author's description of the Marine Corps emblem as the Eagle, Oak and Anchor. Every Marine knows the "Eagle, Globe & Anchor." We don't call it the Silver Leaf!

The idea that no one person makes a group but can contribute to the lasting legacy is one we can all relate to. This falls on my must read list for any student of leadership.
