

This is my favorite of the books that Swoonreads has published so far. The writing is excellent, smart, fast, and clever (full of literary allusions that make it even more interesting on a deeper level for those of us who catch them, but won't slow down anyone who doesn't catch them). The

characters are wonderful, too. Maddy is brilliant, courageous, and resourceful, but still a believable teenager, and Gabe is nowhere near perfect, but still perfect for her. And the passages when the author describes the figure skating are just beautiful in and of themselves.
