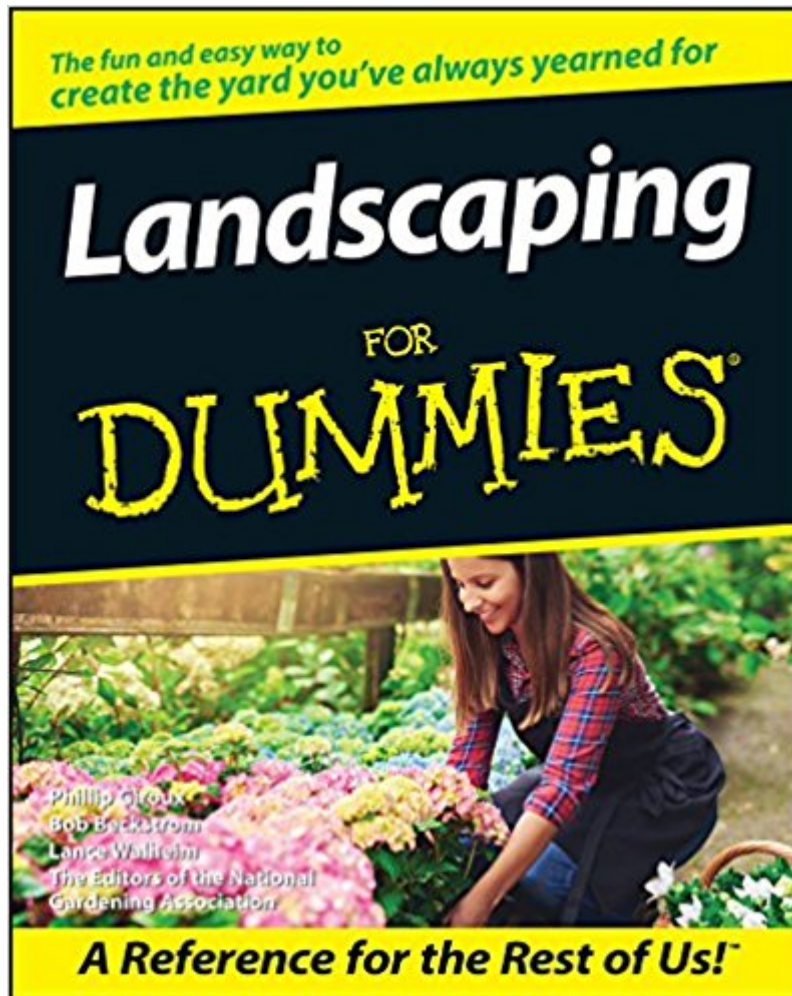

Beginning with a Wish List, the authors help gardeners achieve the yard of their dreams. Icons are used to point out important information.
