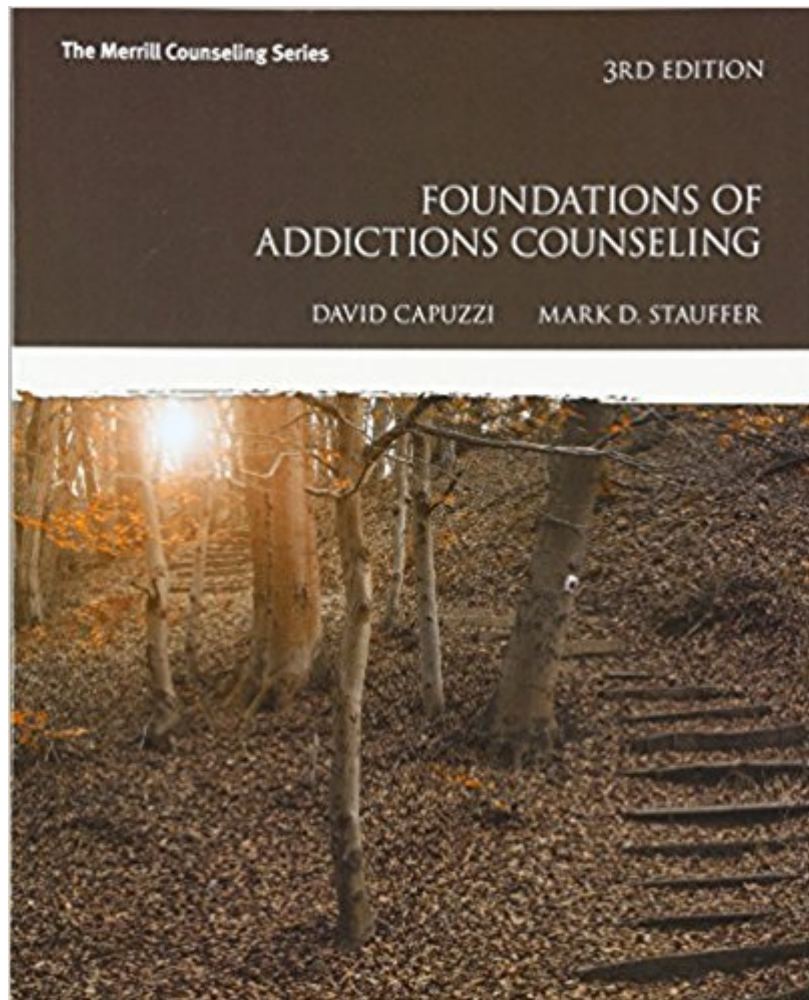

I'm reading this text for a class on addictions and I have to admit I'm finding it painful. The book is so poorly written. I find myself frequently rereading awkward passages. There are other sentences that -- even after a second reading -- make no sense (e.g., "...workaholics tend to have more than

one addiction, perhaps as many as 20%"). This is just shoddy writing and lazy editing. I don't know how this book is in its 3rd edition, but there has to be a better addictions text out there.
