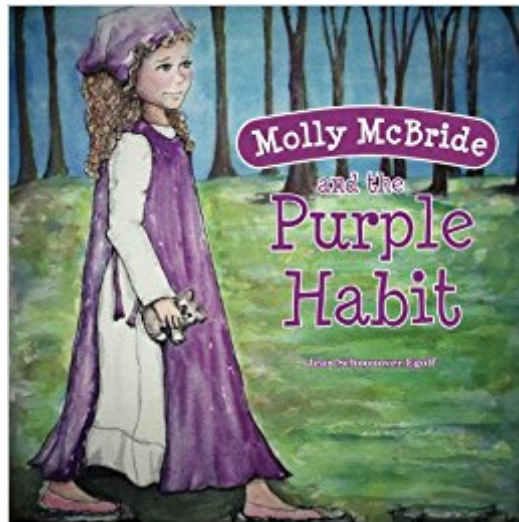

Through a conversation with Children of Mary Sister Bernadette, Molly learns what it means to have a vocation to become a religious sister. So many girls today do not experience a joyful relationship with a religious sister to open their hearts to the possibility of a religious vocation. This book can act as a blessing to open their minds and their hearts to the possibility that they too might be called to be a Bride of Christ.
