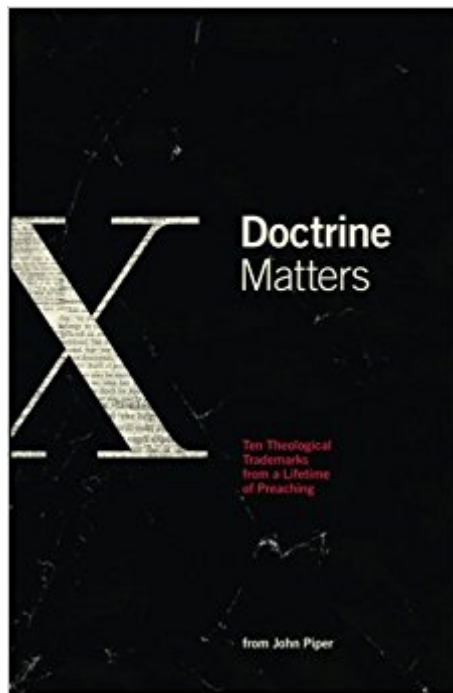




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Doctrine Matters: Ten Theological Trademarks From A Lifetime Of Preaching

Note, however, that there are some extras for each chapter that was not in the sermons. As for the theological content, all ten trademarks are pretty much biblical foundations and any Christian should already have in their hearts. A great read and helps any new or old

Who among us can question the holy legacy and doctrinal soundness of John Piper's ministry? Yet this book gives only a cursory defense of ten heavyweight and essential doctrines. If you care about neo-reformed theology enough to read these reviews, then I recommend you study each one of them in a more robust format; say, from Piper's books. Bottom line: This book doesn't have the space to do any of its topics any real justice.
