One of the most disappointing book I have ever read. Had great characters, and interesting plot, and a lot of potential. Unfortunately, the story didn't hold up. The protagonist finds an ancient, magic weapon in the beginning and I was looking forward to seeing what he accomplished with it. Spoiler alert, he does nothing. He never uses it. In the last 10 percent of the book he starts to learn how to use a sword, but other than that he does nothing interesting. This book was chapter after chapter of the main character wandering from town to town, trying to learn how to use his artifact. The entire time I was thinking, hopefully next chapter he will figure it out and become somewhat less worthless. Never happened. At the end of the book when the protagonist still hadn't figured out how to use the weapon, I couldn't help but feel like I had wasted my time.

This is a wonderful book and an amazing author. I've read his other book "Here lies no one", and his talent, imagination and creativity just keeps improving. It is worth much more than its price. I already look forward for what's next.

I dislike stories that have to do with "destiny" Incredibly boring story following a main character who doesn't really do anything besides wander around and proclaim how he has to help everyone. The bad guy is introduced before the main character and you already know the gist of the ending...
MAIN CHARACTER 1 masters his destined powers through tribulations and sacrifice to defeat MAIN BAD GUY 1. There are no monsters and only 2 tyrants in this book, Flinn has no real conflict throughout the book because he's too weak to have a real conflict. Sure he has an ancient super bracer that makes people super powerful but it doesn't work for him and it never does in the entire book. For all intents and purposes he is a normal soldier with less than proficient training in anything related to combat, wandering around a battlefield of super heroes with nothing happening to him.
PLOT ARMOR. Overall it's a boring book where if the main character didn't exist nothing would change. I'd read the next book if the story itself wasn't so generic and the world so small. You don't always need clear cut bad guys with the fate of the world in the balance, why is the world so small that one guy and a rag-tag cult can threaten it?

Very good book, I liked the characters and the storyline is like a cross between a grimdark tale, lite fare, and epic fantasy. Very well told and I rushed through the reading in a day and a half. Looking forward to the next book.
