

Why not take the time to write an ending, instead of acting irresponsibly for the sake of getting another book out of the plot line?

I read the first three books in this series because I liked how the main character, Abby Morgan, was learning to get on with her life after the tragic death of her husband. Unfortunately, it became very apparent toward the end of the second book that the author had deliberately decided to make Abby into some kind of silly Superwoman and her writing went downhill after that. Since I didn't pay for these books I decided to keep reading them with the hope that they'd get better and that Abby would revert back into the thoughtful, interesting character she was in the first book. I should have known that wasn't going to happen. This fourth book in this series has the murder take place at the end of a convoluted, badly written, and boring story that makes no sense. The Author's explanation that she hadn't planned to make this book a cliffhanger is obviously a bunch of baloney. She wrote it and published it with that ending so that had to be her intent no matter what she says. It's a deliberate and calculated attempt to make sure the reader buys the next book to find out whodunit. Even though I wouldn't have to pay to read the fifth book I won't bother to get it. I will never read anything written by this person again. Notice that I deliberately didn't refer to her as an author. These books are self-published and the term "vanity press" totally applies to this poorly written

series that started out so promising.
