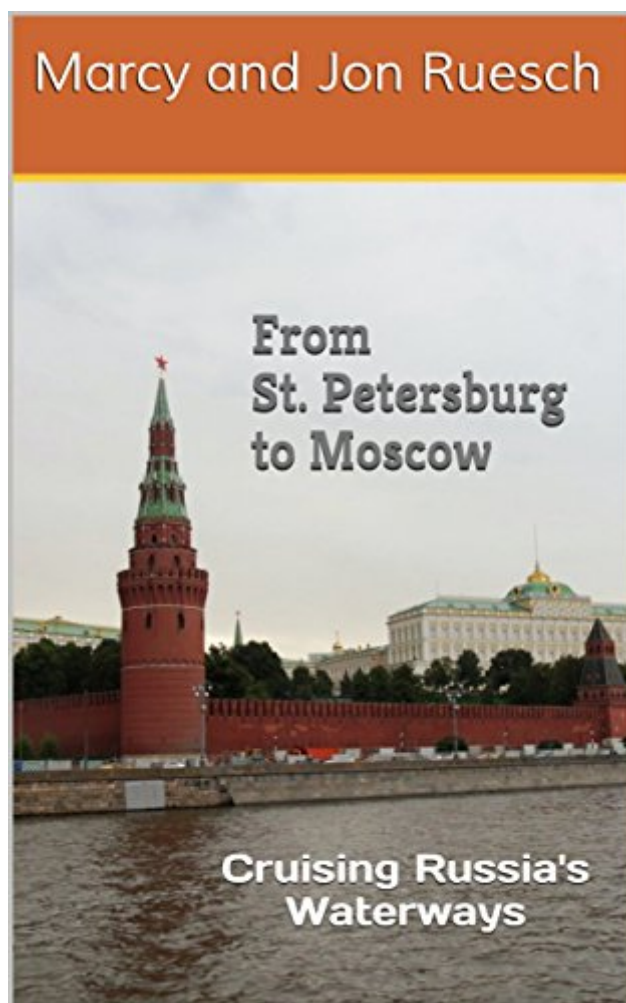

I really enjoyed reading "From St. Petersburg to Moscow: Cruising Russia's Waterways" by Marcy & Jon Ruesch. Marcy makes the point early on that this book isn't a guidebook. Rather, it's a more personal sharing of their travel experience. After reading some of Marcy and Jon's other travel books, I always had the feeling I had been along on the trip. This book is no exception. It covers their 13-day river cruise from St. Petersburg to Moscow. Marcy's writing style is very entertaining and the book has some really funny moments. It's also filled with great details about the various tours they took at each stop on land, life aboard a cruise ship, as well as the background lectures and classes offered on the ship. Marcy describes their adventures in St. Petersburg, Mandrogy, Kizhi Island, Goritzky, Yaroslavl, Uglich and Moscow. She shares the sites they saw, her favorite stops, some historical background, and occasional tips. The photographs are really excellent. I also found some of the political insights interesting as well. This is an excellent book for: 1. Travelers considering a trip to Russia 2. Travelers wondering if a river cruise would work for them 3. Couch potatoes who like to read travel adventures from the comfort of home. Great book. I highly recommend it.

I thoroughly enjoyed reading the story of the author's river cruise from St. Petersburg down to Moscow. I led tours in both cities for 11 years and expected to find some misinterpretations of what the local guides had told Jon and Marcy Ruesch. But try as I might, I found all their information to be spot on, and I love having the chance to re-live my times in these two world class cities. The river cruise between the two cities was new for me and something that I've wanted to do for many years, but I was too busy leading tours. Marcy's story has now motivated me to try to find time for this very cruise. If you have any interest in visiting this part of the world, pick up this book for inspiration.
