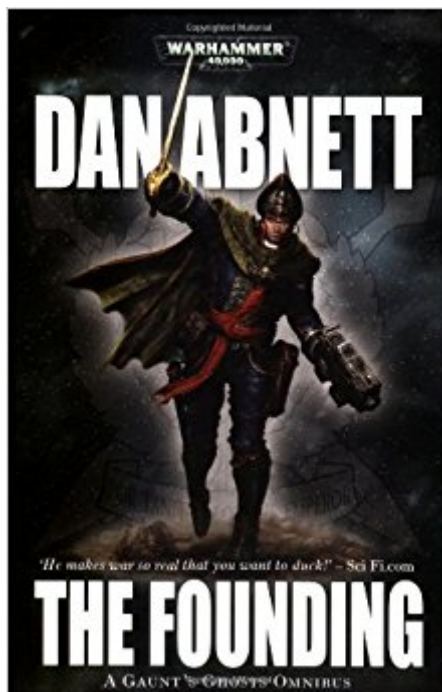

Dan Abnett lives and works in Maidstone, Kent, in England. Well known for his comic work, he has written everything from the Mr Men to the X-Men. His work for the Black Library includes the popular strips Lone Wolves, Titan and Darkblade, the best-selling Gaunt's Ghosts novels, and the acclaimed Inquisitor Eisenhorn trilogy.

Omnibus contains book 1 to 3 of the series: First and only, Ghostmaker and Necropolis; plus the bonus feature of In remembrance. You don't have to be a warhammer fan to love this, that's right, despite all the vast space and super weapons and daemonic antagonists and stuff that you would undoubtedly find in a science fiction novels, the stories are real, realer than real, so are the characters. I really love how the writer develops them thoroughly throughout the journey. The battles are epic indeed but not for the weak-hearted since there are many scenes that involve violent and gore. All in all, the writing style is unique and very interesting. Unlike other books which you just

finish and put out, this one with pull your eyes for a lot longer. It pulls mine. Still reading the third time, and still love it.

There's nothing else to say, if you like grim dark and having your heroes be subject to forces they can't control both from the enemy and their supposed allies you will like this. Buckle up guardsman you might not even live until this evening.

If you are looking for far future action, look no further. Truly well written with great and vastly differentiated characters.
