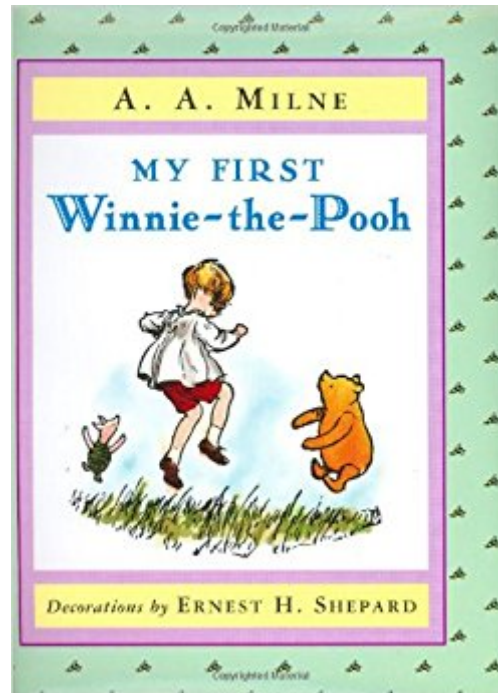

A. A. Milne was born in 1882 in London. He was a playwright and journalist as well as a poet and storyteller. His classic children's books were inspired by his son, Christopher Robin. Milne died in 1956. Ernest H. Shepard was born in 1879 in England. His pictures of the Pooh characters are based on real toys owned by Christopher Robin Milne. Shepard died in 1976.

The edge of the pages of this little book is gilded, but the gold powder comes off and stays on one's fingers after handling. This, to my mind, is unacceptable in the case of a children's book. Who can wash a toddler's hand every time he touches a book? I prefer non-toxic children's books to "beauteous" ones.

I bought this book because the theme of our nursery is Classic Pooh and I bought just about everything I could find that was Classic Pooh. Each of the stories are really just short blurbs. Most don't rhyme very well or have much flow...but the illustrations are beautiful. There is one chapter called The Engineer...this is maybe our favorite part of any book we own even if this book as a whole isn't our favorite. It rhymes, has a great flow, and is lots of fun. My 4 month old has loved that one since she was 2 months old. Look forward to reading these to her more as she gets older and can appreciate them a little more. UPDATE 9/4/15: My little girl is 9 months old and she really seems to like this book. When there are a bunch for her to grab...this is usually the one she goes for. We keep it on the floor with her other toys because she likes to lay on the floor and flip through the pages. This book is well made and has stood up well to daily use. I know she's not reading the book on her own at this age...but it is so adorable to see her laying on the floor, flipping the pages, and studying the pictures...even if the book is upside down...maybe even especially when the book is upside down. I am very happy with this item and so is my baby girl!
