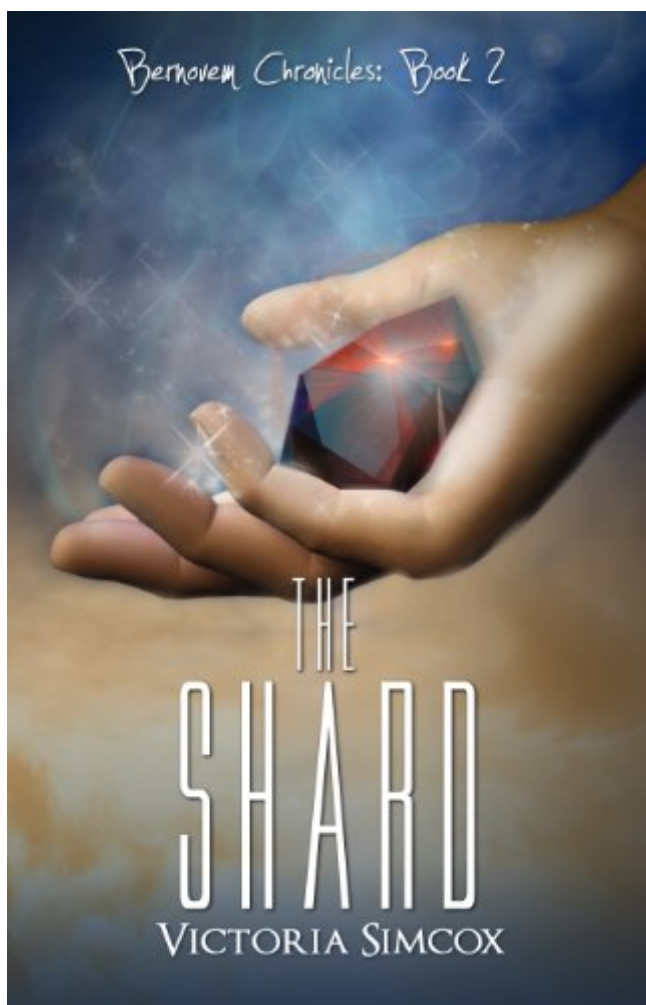


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The Shard (The Bernovem Chronicles Book 2)

Victoria Simcox's *The Shard* brings us *The Warble* as the first book in *The Bernovem Chronicles: The Warble* and what I believe will be a beloved fairy tale, by weaving together seamlessly a great folk tale and myth to create a fantasy that children as well as adults will enjoy through the ages as much as *The Wizard of Oz*! Though years have passed between first and second books, and the children have gotten older, they are very much as we discovered them to be. Now, however, once they are again whisked into the land of fairies and scares choices play out in a more meaningful way making this a tale of loves first bloom for our hero and heroine and for one of the other children, much like in 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory', a cautionary tale, which I applaud, for I believe the best novels show that choices have consequences. Yet, here again - since this is all make believe reminiscent of 'Peter Pan' - once back in their real world the children continue to mature as their nature leads them, or do they? A Truly Fantastical Book! *The Shard* is the sequel to *The Warble* and takes place 3 years later. The main characters have grown and so has the plot of the story. The Author, Victoria Simcox has woven an intricate tale of light and dark. Not that this series is similar to *The Lion, The Witch, and The Wardrobe*, the symbolism is right on. Werrien and Kristina are pure sweetness. Werrien a now handsome and a strong 17 year old, and Kristina is growing into a beauty at fifteen. A few symbolic moments in the book: "My name is Envy.....and Vengeance" ~ says the dark creature to Kristina. You may see yourself as weak, is actually the opposite as Yolen sees you. He sees what you perceive as your weakness, combined with your humility, as your strength. "When you were at your life's lowest moment and you faced total depravity, you did not become bitter...." "I knew you even before the world of Bernovem and your world, Earth were created. It was Yolen that placed the seed of faith inside of you when you were born." These are just a few samples of this delightful novel. And what I didn't know until I reached the last page...this really isn't the end....

In *The Shard*, Kristina is back, along with the less-than-friendly Hester and Davina. What starts out as an innocent trip to summer camp turns into a wild journey through the mystical land of Bernovem. In her travels, an older, more mature Kristina meets up with old friends and enemies. The

charming Prince Werrien captivates our heroine's heart once again. Overall, this installment of the Bernovem Chronicles is a work of art. From the interesting beginning, to the heart-stopping final page, it's an exhilarating spin through a land reminiscent of Narnia or Wonderland!
