I've enjoyed reading the works of the Annapolis Remote Viewing Group, but as disclaimers often say on works of a similar nature, "for entertainment purposes only." Certainly, Robert Raymondsson's recounting of his family, childhood, and near-death experiences (NDEs) were very entertaining, and he should seriously consider expanding those into a novel or something, but they appear to be the only things in this work resembling any kind of truth. Certainly, some of the "predictions" would make great movies plots, and you have to wonder if that's what they're really

seeing. Especially the predictions about Trump, which read more like a Liberal wet dream fantasy than anything based in truth. Funny, too, that in another Annapolis Remote Viewing Group book, "Remote Viewing the Donald Trump Administration," they explicitly say, "In 2018 or 2019 Trump suffers a cerebrovascular or cardiovascular incident that requires him first to relinquish powers to the vice-president and then to leave office for good." This, of course, contradicts the predictions in this book, which also doesn't mention the previous prediction. And the previous book has a whole bunch of predictions not in this book. Go figure, literally.

But reserve the right to pass judgement on the predictions until after next year (2018). As with all psychic predictions, this should be taken with a grain of salt but it was fascinating to learn of their take on what may be in store for the United States during the next two years.

For me it will be very interesting to watch which events unfold, and which do not occur. We are living in interesting times.

I have read other books by this group, and while I can't say much about the accuracy of their predictions, I do find them interesting.

If the public doesn't wake up, I see some of this happening. It seems we have lost the ability to think for ourselves. We have become like sheep, needing someone to lead us.

After purchasing and reading most of the Annapolis remote viewing group publications, I have to report this one is positively squirrely! The main difference seems to be an incorporation of research and footwork into their methodology. On the surface this sounds great, but I sense a corresponding loss of arbitrariness. Interesting but in the end off-putting.

Interesting... Would be great to follow-up on accuracy at some point.

The easy conversational flow of the book is charming; reading it is like chatting quietly with an old friend. Very glad the group is back in business! As always the predictions are interesting. If you hunger for nonstop gloom and disaster, look elsewhere for your drama. Not that there aren't worrisome items--please God, let the stuff about Trump come true in an alternate universe, not here--but there are also intriguing and even funny predictions.
