

Though the pup isn't all Froggy expected—in one scene he fetches mom's underwear instead of a stick-Froggy bonds with the pet after cuddling

in bed and waking up to wet puppy kisses. Froggy is a bit dismayed when the day begins again with a trip outside with the dreaded pooper scooper. London writes with a focus on creating a lively read-aloud experience, while offering an important lesson about responsibility.
